## Allotments

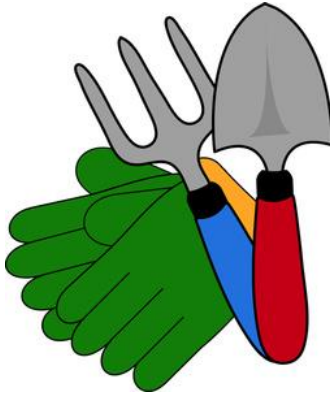
It's Spring - time to get out and garden!

## Parish Council Meeting Dates

## "COUNCIL CORNER"

### December 2015:

- The council agreed terms with ERYC to lease the vacant Citizen Link Kiosk in the village for use as a document archive.
- The council approved a pension provider for all council employees to comply with auto enrolment workplace pension legislation.
- The Clerk successfully completed the Introduction to Local Council Administration qualification.

### January 2016:

- The Parish Council considered the budget, precept request and resultant impact to Council Tax payer for the 2016/17 year.  
£38,300 will be needed to run village services which means an increase to Council Tax payers from £44.36 in 2015/16 to £45.12 in 2016/2017 based on a Band D property.  
A government grant of £1,241 will be paid via ERYC to the Parish to help to mitigate the effects of the change in Council Tax calculations for 2016/2017.
- Natalie Venning – ERYC Digital Services Officer delivered a presentation to the council on Superfast Broadband and availability in the area. For further information contact the ERYC Broadband Team on [broadband@eastriding.gov.uk](mailto:broadband@eastriding.gov.uk).
- A consultation on Flamborough's Community Governance Review proposal would be running from 13 January to 29 February.
- The council approved for the Clerk to undertake further professional development and work towards the Certificate in Local Council Administration.

### February 2016:

- The council approved the co-option of a new councillor – Brian Maxwell.
- The council continued to work with ERYC to resolve the flooding issues in the village, particularly in the area near the post office.
- Councillor Leppington laid the wreath on behalf of the council on the Fishing Memorial.

### Extra Ordinary Meeting February 2016

- The council held an extra ordinary meeting to discuss an application from Flamborough Pre-School to erect a fence around an area of village green adjacent to the WI Hall.
- Following advice received from ERYC, East Riding & North East Lincolnshire Council Association and the legal advisers at the Society of Council Clerks, the Council unanimously approved to allow the Pre-School to use an area of village green land for outdoor play and learning.
