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Council Meetings What are they for?

Flamborough Parish Council meetings are public meetings so everyone is welcome to attend. They are held at 7.30pm in the WI Hall on the first Monday of the month (or the second Monday if there is a bank holiday) The Parish Council has powers to look after many aspects of the village and is your voice at the most local of levels. Last year the Council amongst many other things:

- Installed a new climbing frame, 2 rockers and a roundabout in the play area on the village green.
- Liaised with police to reduce antisocial behavior
- Negotiated a new electricity contract so residents would pay less for street lighting
- Installed street lights where residents had identified safety concerns
- Bought new Christmas lights for the village and erected these

Safe and Sound Scheme

East Riding of Yorkshire Council have launched a 'Safe and Sound' grant for home owners and private tenants. The grant is to help minimise the fear of crime by providing additional home security measures to enable residents to feel safer in their home.

To qualify for assistance applicants must be:

- Aged over 60 or disabled
- In receipt of a means tested benefit
- A homeowner or private sector tenant/Housing Association tenant

Measures include:

- Additional locks for doors and windows
- Door chains
- Door viewers
- Security lights

"COUNCIL CORNER"

As a statutory consultee your council considers all planning applications for the village at the meetings. It also has responsibility for the allotments on Bempton Lane and orders any maintenance work needed or changes in tenancies. In addition your Council, amongst other things has done the following:

April

The Council considered the results of the annual inspection of the playground on the village green and ordered additional matting to improve the safety underfoot for all the children using this facility. It also looked at road safety on North Marine road and other sites in the village and wrote to East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) about these matters.

May

Councillors accompanied staff from ERYC around the village to identify areas that needed improvement. Council and ERYC then agreed to a timetable for carrying out the work needed.

Councillors placed a wreath on Fisherman's Gardens in memory of the fishermen who lost their lives in the Carol Sandra disaster.

June

The Council discussed and approved in principle the installation of planters around Fisherman's Gardens in the village.

Parking near the Co-op

The Council have recently erected No Parking signs by the access road at the side of the Small Green near the Co-op. This is because access is needed along this road **at all times**.
