"COUNCIL CORNER"

As a statutory consultee your council considers all planning applications for the village at the meetings. It also has responsibility for the allotments on Bempton Lane and orders any maintenance work needed or changes in tenancies. In addition your Council, amongst other things has done the following:

August

The Council agreed to maintenance work and painting of the public toilets near the Dog and Duck to keep them in good order. .

September

The Fire Festival Committee gave a talk at the Council meeting about the planned changes to the event for New Year's Eve 2018 including staging the main display at the Village Green rather than Chapel Street.

October

The Council ordered the anchor points for festive lighting to be checked to ensure the safety of the public.

November

The Council attended the unveiling of the Steel Soldier statue at Flamborough Primary School and also attended the Remembrance Day ceremony on 11 November. Allotment rents were collected from most of the plot holders. The Council arranged for maintenance of the Village Green fencing prior to the Fire Festival on New Year's Eve.
