

North Landing

From Flamborough Village, take the B1255 signposted to North Landing. Here you will find a picturesque bay, chalk cliffs and rocks and caves to explore. There is car parking (pay and display), toilet facilities, the Caravel Bar and café. The North Star Restaurant is adjacent and situated along the B1255.

The sandy beach is accessed by foot via a steep road (authorized vehicles only have access). Local fishermen provide scenic boat trips round the caves and bird sanctuaries and fishing trips are also provided.

There are cliff walks to Thornwick Bay from the west scar and round to the Lighthouse from the east scar, both walks taking in picturesque scenery and a must for birdwatchers keen to spot wild and sea birds.
